

Krupalaya Care Home, Villupuram

On October 3rd 2025, A motivational and career guidance session was organized at Krupalaya Care Home, Villupuram, benefiting 63 participants.

The session aimed at inspiring young learners to overcome challenges and believe in their potential. Topics covered included personal discipline, communication skills, and identifying individual strengths. Interactive activities encouraged students to set achievable goals and work towards them confidently.







Orientation for Don Bosco Youth Leaders @ Ennore

On October 5th 2025, an inspiring orientation was conducted for Don Bosco Youth Leaders in Ennore, engaging 53 enthusiastic youth.

The session focused on leadership values, teamwork, and the importance of community service. Participants were motivated to take on leadership roles in their communities, demonstrating responsibility, empathy, and initiative in their personal and professional lives.

Prelims Screening - Motivational & Aptitude Session

On October 8th 2025, A combined Motivational and Aptitude Screening Session was held for community students at AVC, with 87 beneficiaries.

This program was designed to prepare students for competitive examinations and to strengthen their logical reasoning and analytical skills. Students also received guidance on time management, exam strategies, and stress handling — crucial elements for academic success.







Mock Interview Sessions @ AVC

On October 9th & 10th 2025, Two separate mock interview sessions were organized at AVC to enhance students' job readiness and interview confidence.

- First session: 48 students benefited.
- Second session: 45 students benefited.

These sessions simulated real interview experiences and provided constructive feedback to students on body language, communication, and presentation skills. Trainers offered personalized suggestions for improvement, helping students prepare for professional interactions.

Career Guidance sessions at St. Mary's Anglo Indian Hr. Sec. School

On October 15th 2025, the department conducted two career guidance sessions at St. Mary's Anglo Indian Higher Secondary School, tailored to suit academic streams:

- Science Stream: 95 students
- · Arts Stream: 67 students

The focus was to help students understand the relationship between subject choices and future career paths.







BEST Program @ Perambur

On October 17th 2025, A short yet impactful BEST Program was conducted in Perambur, engaging 7 participants. Despite the small group, the session had a deep impact —

emphasizing self-awareness, motivation, and essential soft skills. Students were trained on personal branding, communication etiquette, and maintaining a growth mindset.

Mock Interview Session for MIS Batch 10458 and Tally Students

On October 24th 2025, A specialized mock interview training session was organized for MIS Batch 10458 and Tally students, with 19 participants.

The session was designed to simulate corporate interview environments, preparing students for actual recruitment processes. Emphasis was placed on presentation, confidence, communication skills, and resume enhancement.







Orientation on UPSC Examination



TALLY EXAMINATION

On October 4th and 1sth, Tally examinations were organized for Batch 10035 and Batch 10034. The assessments aimed to evaluate the students' practical and theoretical knowledge.

A total of 23 students participated in the examination. The test was conducted in a structured and professional manner. Students showcased their understanding of key accounting concepts. It was a successful evaluation session for both batches.

PLACEMENT ORIENTATION

On October 7th, a Placement Orientation Program was organized for Batch 10458 and Batch 10459. The session was conducted by Mrs. Sindhu, focusing on LinkedIn profile creation and professional email ID setup. Students learned how to build ATS-friendly resumes suitable for online job applications. They were also guided on updating their documents for placement readiness. The session included training on effectively using job portals. A total of 25 students from both batches actively participated in the program.

DOMAIN BASELINE ASSESMENT



On October 17th, a Baseline Assessment was conducted for Batch 10575 of the Finance and Accounting Executive program. The assessment aimed to evaluate the students' foundational knowledge and skills. It served as an initial step to track their learning progress throughout the course. Students participated actively and demonstrated their basic understanding of accounting concepts. A total of 10 students took part in the assessment.

The session helped identify key areas for improvement and future focus.

AAA-CHARGE YOUR MIND

A Motivational Session was conducted on the topic "The 3 A's for a Positive Life." The session focused on the core values of Accept, Adjust, and Appreciate. It aimed to inspire students to develop a positive mindset and emotional balance. Interactive discussions and real-life examples made the session engaging. Participants shared reflections on how to apply these values in daily life. A total of 40 students actively participated in the session.





CAREER GUIDANCE SESSION

On October 17th, a Career Guidance Session was organized for Batch 10575 on the topic "Know Yourself Better, "The session aimed to help students identify their strengths, interests, and career goals. Through interactive activities, participants reflected on their personal and professional aspirations. The trainer guided them on aligning their skills with suitable career paths. Students gained valuable insights into self-awareness and goal setting.

The session received positive feedback for its motivational and practical approach.

MOCK INTERVIEW

On October 27th, Mock Interviews were conducted by our Career Guidance Team for Batch 10458 and Batch 10459. The activity aimed to prepare students for real-world interview experiences. Participants were assessed on communication, confidence, and presentation skills. Constructive feedback was provided to help them improve their performance. The session boosted students' readiness for upcoming placement opportunities. A total of 19 students actively participated in the mock interview session.





PRE-INTERVIEW PREPARATION

On October 29th, Mr. Neethi Maanikkam conducted a Pre-Interview Preparation Session for Batch 10459 of the Finance and Accounting Executive program. The session focused on enhancing students' interview skills, communication, and confidence. Key topics included body language, common interview questions, and professional etiquette. Students actively engaged in mock Q&A rounds and practice discussions. The session helped them gain clarity on how to present themselves effectively. A total of 11 students participated in the training session.

TMF VISIT & INTERNAL AUDIT

On October 14th, an Internal Audit was conducted by Mr. Arul for Q1 batches 10034, 10035, 10036, 10233, and 10191. The audit focused on reviewing documentation, student records, and training progress. It helped ensure program quality and compliance with institutional standards. Following the audit, an Orientation Session was organized for Batch 10459 and Batch 10575. The session briefed students on course structure, expectations, and learning objectives. A total of 23 students participated in the orientation program.





Orientation Program @ Bharathi Women's College

An orientation session was held on October 6, 2025, at Bharathi Women's College to introduce the new 4-month Skill Training Centre on campus. The session aimed to make final-year students aware of the training opportunities available. Trainers explained the course structure, duration, and main skill modules. A total of 10 students participated actively. Mr. Susai Raj led an interview preparation session, offering guidance and feedback to improve students' confidence and performance. Both sessions were highly interactive, informative, and well-received by the participants.









Prelims Screening Process - Aptitude Test for AVC Final Year Students

On 8th October 2025, an Aptitude Session was conducted for AVC College final-year students by Mr. Susai and Mr. Neethimaanikam. The session focused on strengthening problem-solving, logical reasoning, and quantitative skills.

Center Manager Ms. Sindhu Alphonsa then gave an orientation on the training courses offered at the centre.

A Preliminary Screening for the upcoming Q4 batch was also conducted. Out of 87 students, 81 actively participated in the aptitude test. The overall session was interactive, insightful, and beneficial for students' career preparation.

Second Round of Screening - Face-to-Face Interviews for AVC Students

On 9th and 10th October 2025, the second round of the Screening Process was conducted for AVC College final-year female students. A face-to-face interview was held to assess communication, attitude, and employability skills. The interviews were conducted by Mr. Susai and Mr. Neethimaanikam along with AVC team members. On 9th October, 48 students attended, and on 10th October, 45 students participated. The process helped identify students ready for placement and those needing additional support.

Overall, the sessions were well-coordinated, productive, and provided valuable feedback for improvement.








World Food Day Celebration

Digital Marketing Session


