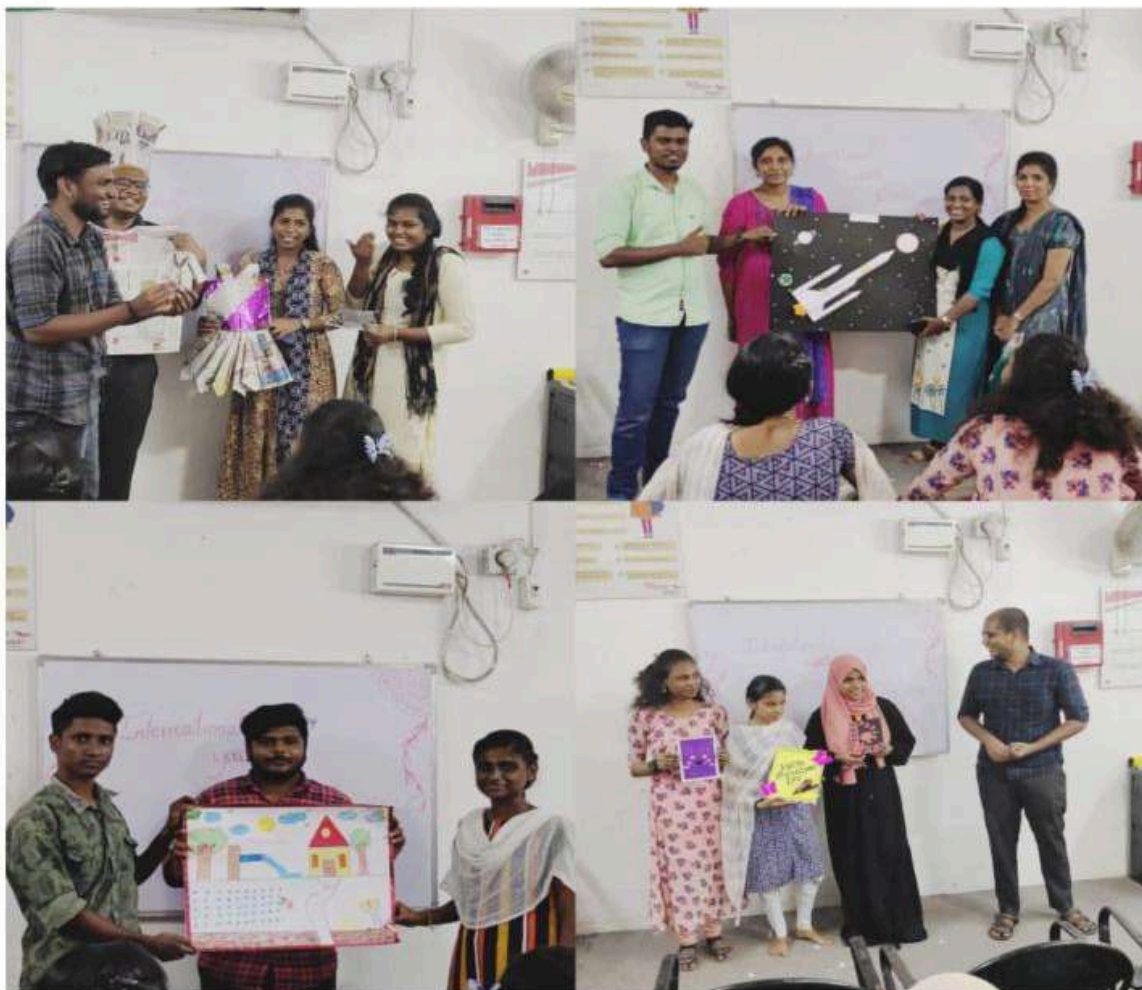

Karpagambal A
