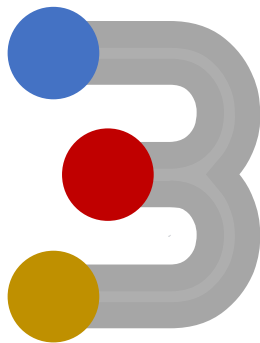

A blood donation camp was organized at the center in association with Cross Blood Foundation, Chennai. The camp helped the students to understand the significance of blood donation.

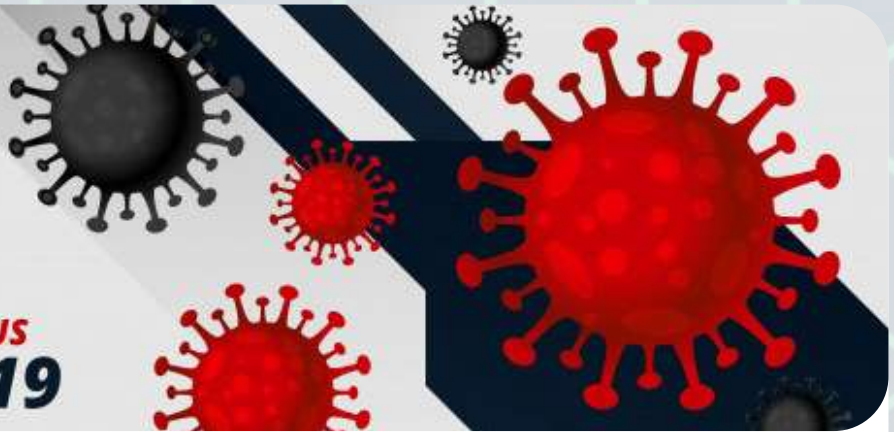
