

## **Department of Job Placement Services**

## **Company Onboarding and Job Vacancies**

DBV has successfully onboarded three companies during October 2024—Pradee Queen, MMC Infotech, and SBI Life—focusing primarily on the BPO and banking sectors. This collaboration has opened up over 100 job vacancies, demonstrating a significant expansion in employment options for job seekers registered with DBV.

## Stakeholder Classification and Demographic Insights

The report includes a detailed classification of stakeholders, illustrating a balanced gender distribution (50% male, 50% female) among job seekers served. Additionally, the organization supports individuals from diverse ages and religious and educational backgrounds, furthering DBV's commitment to inclusivity.



#### **Job Referral and Placement Successes**

DBV has made considerable strides in placing job seekers into employment through multiple channels. In October, 32 candidates from TMF and Quest, along with an additional 35 general job seekers, secured positions. Placement activities included job drives, which led to 10 placements, and direct walk-ins, resulting in 20 placements. Furthermore, three candidates are currently in post-placement followup, underscoring DBV's continuous support even after initial placements to ensure long-term job retention and satisfaction.



## JPN Help Desk Support

The JPN Help Desk, led by JPN Manager Mr John Martin, provided tailored placement assistance to candidates from Ranchi Don Bosco ITI. This support facilitated placements for four individuals with PCA Automobiles, a TVS-associated company, in Tiruvallur. The personal guidance from the JPN Help Desk emphasizes DBV's handson approach to ensuring job seekers are matched



with suitable opportunities. It underscores the importance of targeted assistance in specific industry sectors.




