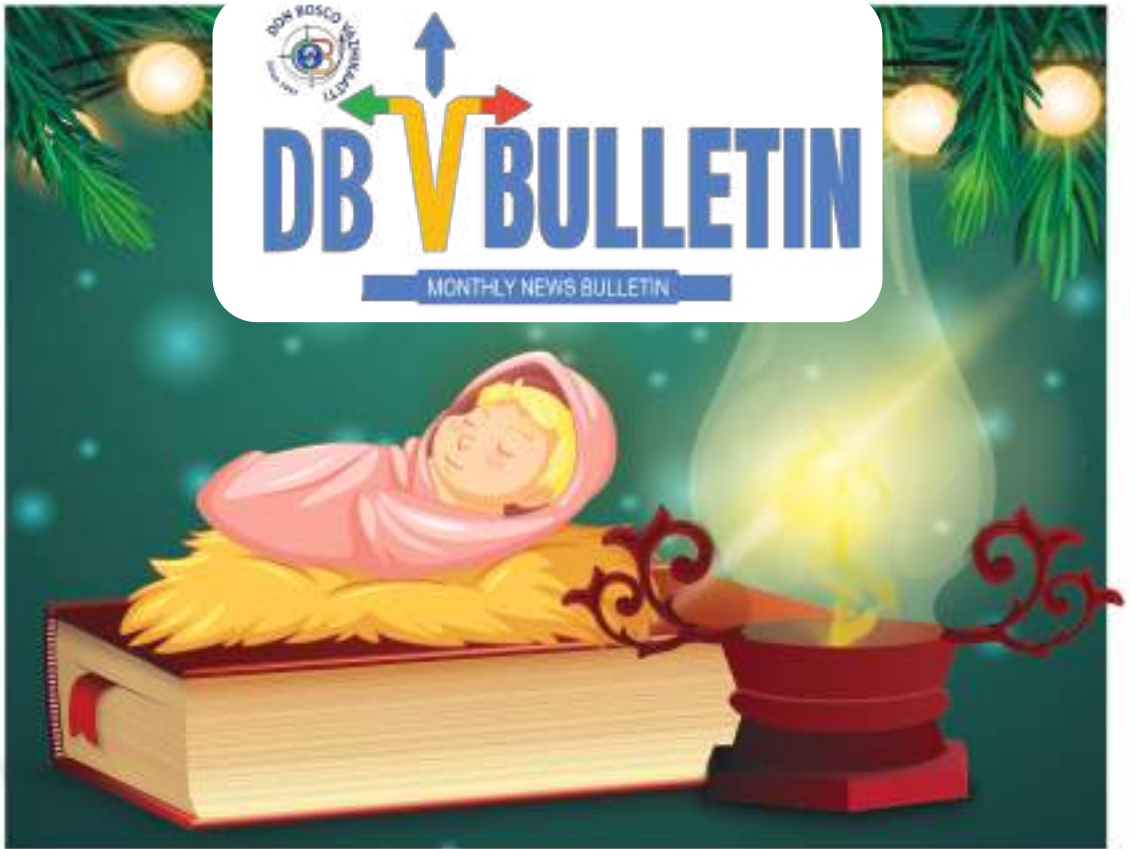

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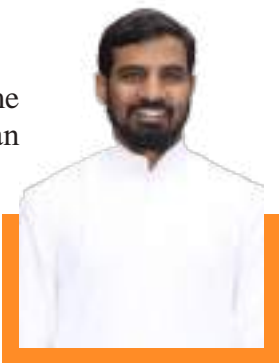

DESCRIPTIVE REPORT - November 2024

Collaboration with the Caribbean Institute - November 6, 2024:

Don Bosco Vazhikaatti, based in Panama City, engaged in a virtual collaboration with Prof. Christian Schöpke from the Institute for Vocational Training in Latin America and the Caribbean. The session highlighted vocational training as a tool for youth



empowerment. Both organizations shared best practices and innovative strategies to improve skills development. The exchange was conducted via Zoom and fostered a rich discussion on global education standards. Topics included technical training methodologies and community engagement approaches. The event emphasized cross-cultural learning and global collaboration. Participants

gained insights into challenges and opportunities in vocational education. This marks a step forward in strengthening international ties. Such partnerships reflect DBV's commitment to holistic education and global impact.

Career Guidance at Pannur - November 7, 2024:

Aptitude Test for DQA Students- November 5, 2024:

The test was an essential step to measure their readiness for career-oriented challenges. Students showed keen interest in completing the test within the stipulated time. Feedback revealed

DBV - QUEST

Monthly Training Progress

Don Bosco Vazhikaatti, in collaboration with Quest Alliance, made significant progress toward training 140 students in 2024. The program successfully trained 31 students in Batch 1, 28 in Batch 2, and 31 in Batch 3, reaching 91 students by November. Mobilization strategies included visits to slum areas, collaborations with Child Welfare Committees, social media campaigns, and door-to-door outreach. Alums also played a key role in encouraging student enrollment. The efforts reflect the dedication to providing quality education and skills training. With these initiatives, the organization is confident about meeting its training goals for the year.

Current Batch Training and Placements

In 2024, Batch 2 saw 28 students complete training, with 12 securing placements and 5 opting for higher studies. Batch 3 commenced with 31 students, reflecting substantial enrollment numbers. Placements showcased diverse opportunities for students in various fields. The program focuses on equipping students with practical skills for career advancement. The results underscore the success of Don Bosco Vazhikaatti's training approach.

Placement Activities and Success

Mega Job Fair at Lourdes Shrine, Perambur: A Resounding Success

Perambur, November 23, 2024 – Don Bosco Vazhikaatti hosted a successful Mega Job Fair at Lourdes Shrine, attracting 303 candidates. The event, a collaborative effort involving students, alums, and community members, was a testament to the organization’s commitment to fostering employability and career development.

A total of 27 companies participated in the fair, offering a wide range of job opportunities across various sectors. Out of the 303 attendees, an impressive 298 candidates secured employment, highlighting the event’s success in bridging the gap between job seekers and employers. Employers praised the candidates’ preparedness, enthusiasm, and professionalism, many of whom were students and alums from Don Bosco Vazhikaatti centres.
