




A total of 135 students participated in this session, which was divided into forenoon (111 students) and afternoon (24 students) sessions. The mock interviews simulated real-world scenarios, providing students with valuable insights into what to expect during actual job interviews.

The establishment of dedicated WhatsApp channels (EDU+ for educational resources and Job Alerts) kept students engaged with useful information, job postings, and career development tips.

d) Don Bosco Vazhikaatti YouTube Channel:

The program participants were encouraged to subscribe to the YouTube channel for educational content, career webinars, and training sessions.

e) Don Bosco Job Placement Network (Jobs DBI app)

connects students and job seekers with potential employers, offering a platform for seamless job placement. It streamlines the process of job matching, providing tools for resume building, job search and career development.

f) Training cum Placement opportunities model

connects student participants with DBV client companies, offering hands-on training followed by potential job placements. This initiative enhances students' skills and increases their employability through real-world industry exposure.

g) Campus Drive & Placement Assistance (March 2025):

A campus drive and placement assistance will be organized in March 2025, providing students an opportunity to directly engage with potential employers.







Innovative Components: Future-Proofing Graduates

- 1. Real-World Career Insights: Industry speakers and HR representatives shared first-hand knowledge about the evolving job market, empowering students to make informed decisions about their future.
- 2. Skill-Based Approach: The focus developing soft skills such as selfmanagement, initiative, and organizational skills was a unique feature, setting the program apart as a holistic career development initiative.
- **3. Mock Interviews & HR Interactions:** By introducing students to mock interviews and HR job orientations, the program gave students an opportunity to experience realworld job interactions before entering the workforce.

- ✓ Overall, the training was considered excellent, with widespread appreciation for the trainers' expertise, engaging delivery, and impactful learning experience.














Suggestions and Expectations.

- ☐ **Learning & Effectiveness:** Most participants felt they learned useful skills and appreciated the trainers. They requested more detailed sessions, especially on interviews and higher studies.
- ☐ **Improvement Suggestions:** People suggested adding more physical sessions, giving extra details on exams (like TNSP), and improving interview preparation.
- ☐ **Career Support:** Many felt the program helped with employability and asked for more focus on personality development and body language.
- ☐ **Program Format:** Some recommended extending the program to 5 days or offering specialized coaching, like for government exams, to better support students.
