# **Department of Job Placement Services**

#### **Candidates Registration:**

From April to December, a total of 1,448 registrations were recorded in JPN. Among these, 47.37% were male and 55.38% were female. In terms of verified jobseekers, there were 1,517 individuals, with 646 males and 802 females. Of these verified jobseekers, opportunities were provided to 997 candidates, broken down into 398 males and 572 females.

## **Post Placement Update:**

A post-placement update was done for all centres, including Tech Mahindra Foundation (Perambur, Broadway, AVC, and Quest Alliance), as well as for walkin and referral candidates. The follow-up process involved tracking the offer letters uploaded in JPN, with the respective counts for each category being provided. These follow-ups ensured that all offer letters were accounted for and appropriately updated in the system.



## **Mock Interview:**

On December 7th, 2024, mock interview session was conducted for TMF Perambur Students, led by Mr. John Martin, the JPN Manager. The session prepared students for job interviews by emphasizing self-presentation, structured answers, and skill demonstration. Mr. Martin highlighted common mistakes like poor company knowledge and body language. Mock

interviews helped students refine responses and boost confidence for future success.

#### Upcoming Job fair At St. Annes College:

The Job Fair Orientation on December 9th, 2024, at St. Anne's College prepared

students for the upcoming job fair by introducing them to participating companies and job roles. It focused on aligning their skills with available opportunities and boosting confidence.
