Session Breakdown

1. "Ace the Interview: Mastering the Art of Preparation" – Mr. Levin

Mr. Levin shared expert advice on how to prepare mentally and physically for interviews, offering valuable tips on research, self-presentation, and effective communication. 3. "Beyond Graduation: Uncovering Career Opportunities" – Fr. Joe Anand

Feedback and impact

The feedback received from 98 students via Google Forms revealed overwhelmingly positive responses, with students appreciating the practical advice and hands-on approach to career readiness. Here are some key takeaways:

• **Engagement:** 92% of respondents felt the program provided them with valuable insights that they could directly apply to their career search.

• **Content Relevance:** 85% found the session on resume building the most beneficial, emphasizing the importance of this tool in job applications.

• Inspiration: 89% expressed a renewed sense of motivation and direction after learning about diverse career opportunities beyond their degree.



Post-BEST Program Follow-Up

To ensure continued support for the students, Don Bosco College has implemented several post program follow-up actions aimed at enhancing career readiness and ensuring a successful transition from education to employment:

• Career Insights Weekly Magazine: A subscription to a career insights magazine will be sent to individual mail IDs, providing students with the latest job trends, interview tips, and industry updates.

• **Tele Counselling:** Personalized one-on-one counselling sessions will be available, offering tailored career advice and job search strategies.

• **DBV WhatsApp Channels:** Dedicated WhatsApp channels will be created for students to receive regular job alerts and updates on educational opportunities (Job Alerts & EDU+).

• YouTube Channel & Placement Network: Career-related content, including job preparation tutorials and industry interviews, will be shared on Don Bosco Vazhikaatti YouTube channel. Additionally, students can access the Don Bosco Job Placement Network (Jobs DBI app) for real t ime job openings.

• Campus Drive & Placement Assistance: Don Bosco College will continue to provide placement assistance through a structured training and placement program, culminating in a campus drive scheduled for March 2025.
