Introduction

The Tamil Nadu Adi Dravidar Welfare Department, in collaboration with MMT and NURTURE, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti, Chennai & Trichy, organized the "என் கல்லூரி கனவு" Career Guidance Program in 2025. This initiative aimed at providing higher education guidance to SC/ST students in Tamil Nadu, helping them make informed career choices. The program spanned across two phases, conducted in March and April 2025, with sessions covering a range of undergraduate courses and career paths.

Program Duration and Structure

The "என் கல்லூரி கனவு" program was organized over a period of two weekends (March & April 2025), conducted over four days. The key objective was to provide career guidance and information about higher education options to 12th-grade students. The sessions were well-organized and saw active participation from students and teachers across several districts in Tamil Nadu.

Q&A Sessions: Interactive sessions addressing students' queries on various career paths and higher education options.

Role of Teachers and Headmasters: Teachers and headmasters are vital in creating an effective learning environment. It is recommended that their involvement be further emphasized to improve the quality of the sessions.



Avoid Unplanned Speeches: It was proposed that instead of unplanned speeches by guests and officials, resource departments could set up information stalls to guide students during breaks.



Career Counselling Services: Offering individual career counselling sessions could provide more personalized guidance to students.



Timely Breaks and Sessions: Adherence to scheduled timings for breaks and lunch would ensure that the program runs efficiently.



Post-Lunch Activities: It was suggested that post-lunch sessions could include career exhibitions or documentary visuals, providing an engaging learning experience for students.



Improvement in Infrastructure: Suggestions were made to improve projector, audio systems, and internet facilities to enhance the quality of the sessions.
