Market Scan





Candidate Registration (April–March)

From April to March, a total of 4,834 candidates were onboarded with JPN. Of these, 4,158 individuals were successfully verified as jobseekers, comprising 1,317 males and 2,841 females. Subsequently, 3,803 verified jobseekers were provided with employment opportunities, including 1,083 males and 2,720 females.

Campus Drives Overview

Bharathi Women's College, Broadway


