Department of Career Guidance

At Don Bosco Vazhikaatti, we believe early exposure to career possibilities empowers students to make informed, confident decisions about their futures. Since its inception in 1997, our Career Guidance for School Students programme has shaped the dreams and ambitions of thousands of young minds. Designed to spark curiosity, build awareness, and nurture aspirations, our services include:

- Career-path exploration
- · One-on-one counselling
- Competitive-exam awareness (NEET, JEE Mains & Advanced, CUET)
- Professional-course guidance (CA, ACCA, CS, CMA, etc.)
- "Career Guidance on Wheels," a mobile digitalvehicle initiative

To date, we have reached **400,398** students through **2,586** programmes since 1997.

Training Programmes Bosco Employability Skills Training (BEST)

Launched in 2012, BEST is our flagship employability-skills initiative, equipping youth with 21st-century competencies—personal skills, social skills, job orientation, and the transition from campus to corporate life. Through interactive sessions, practical exercises, and personalised coaching, BEST has empowered participants to bridge the gap between education and employment.

To date, we have reached **55,515** learners across **231** programmes.

The DBV-TMF SMART Perambur Centre was established on 1 April 2015 as the second centre in the partnership between Don Bosco Vazhikaatti and Tech Mahindra Foundation. Strategically located at DBV headquarters, the centre plays a vital role in equipping youth with the skills and mindset needed for today's competitive job market. The Perambur Centre offers specialized training in:

- Tally Prime
- Data Quality Analysis

Beyond technical skills, the centre fosters a self-learning mindset, encouraging students to take ownership of their growth and to continuously upskill themselves. It serves as a vibrant space where participants gain both industry-relevant knowledge and the personal confidence to thrive in their careers.

- Build professional confidence
- Step into career pathways with purpose and clarity

Don Bosco Job Placement Network (JPN)

Since 2019, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti has collaborated with the Job Placement Network (JPN)—a national initiative of the Salesian Provincial Conference of South Asia—to guide, train, and place underprivileged youth in decent jobs. Through JPN, we help jobseekers build confidence, develop market-ready skills, and connect with real opportunities via walk-in interviews, job fairs, campus drives, and referrals. Sectors served include manufacturing, finance, healthcare, education, hospitality, and more. JPN is officially recognised as a Placement Organisation by the Ministry of Labour and Employment (NCS).
