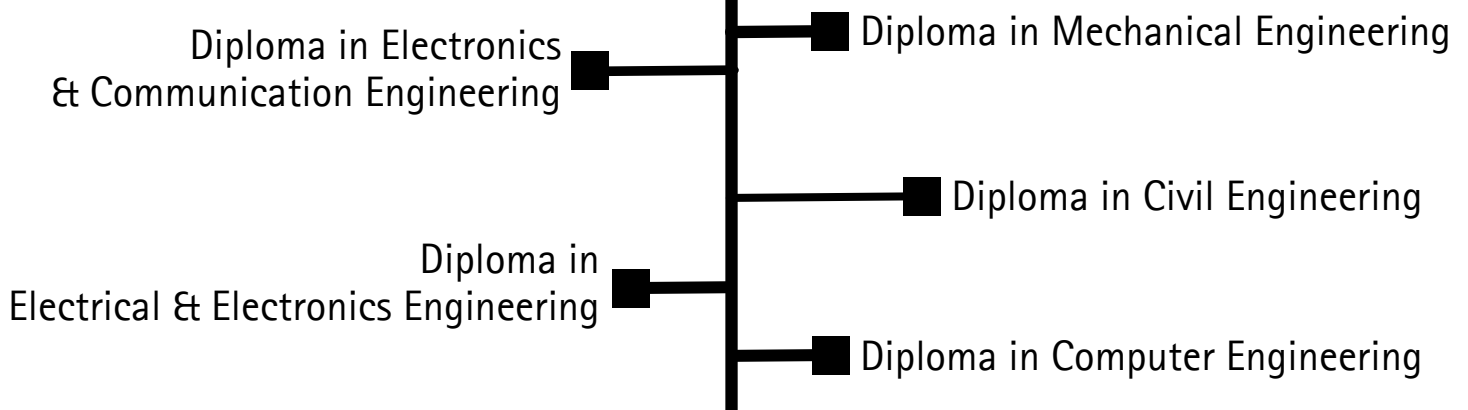

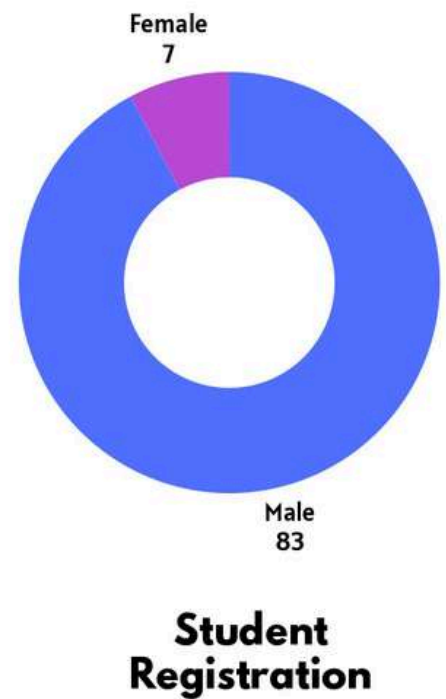
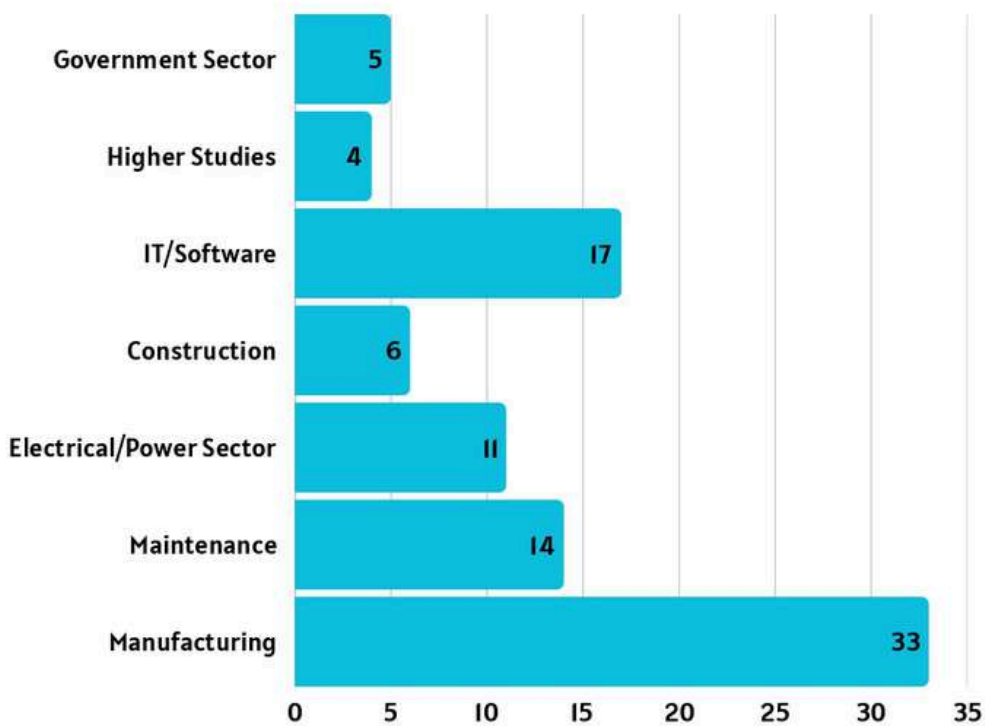

**Preferred Job Role/Industry**



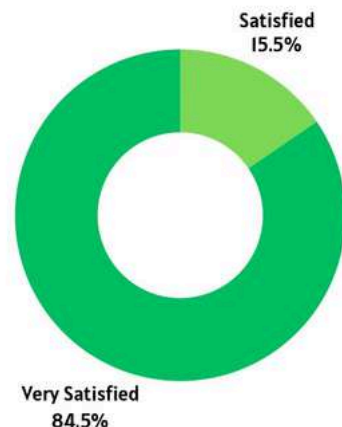

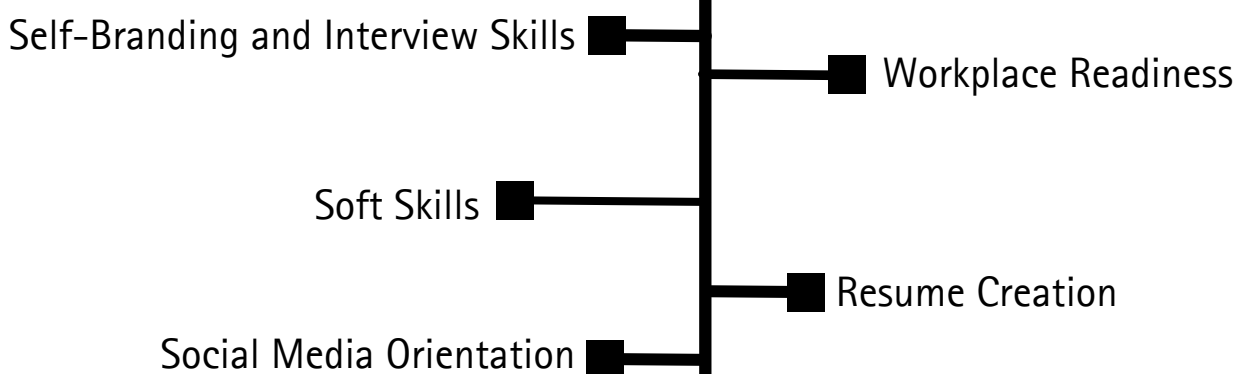

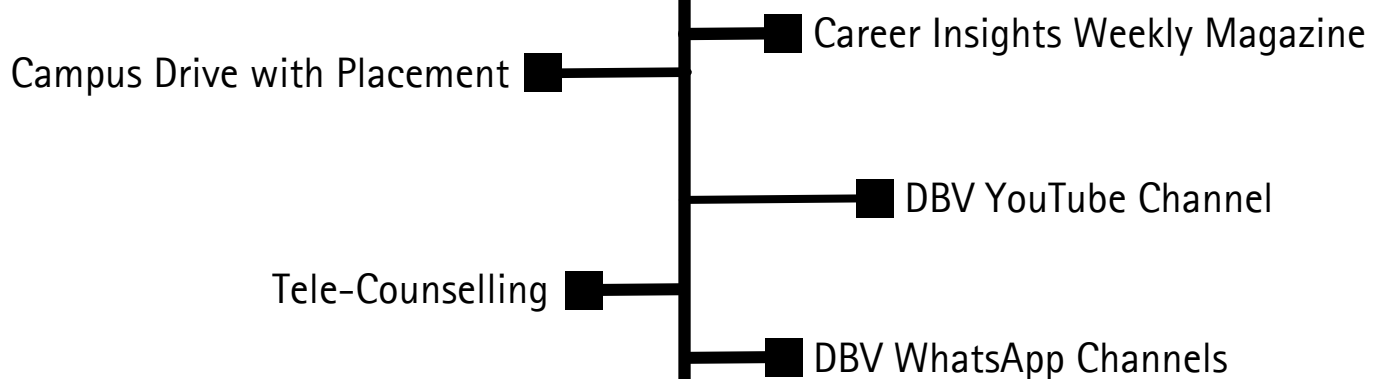
# Feedback

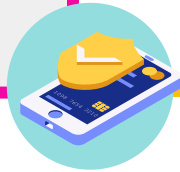
