




#### Career Guidance Program, Don Bosco School, Adamangalam


#### Parenting Skills Session, Fathima School, Kodambakkam




#### Role play by Team Phoenix

From June 10 to 20, 2025, interns from SRM University conducted a 10-day workshop on SQL and Aptitude at DBV SMART Perambur. The program combined technical training in SQL (DDL, DML, DCL, TCL) with placement-focused aptitude sessions. Students engaged in daily hands-on practice, including problem-solving tasks and query writing. Each session was structured to strengthen logical reasoning, number systems, and data handling skills. Interns ensured the learning was interactive and paced for both beginners and intermediate learners. Frequent assessments and exercises helped students build confidence and industry readiness.

#### Aptitude Class Batch Id's 10034,10035,10036

As part of the 10-day SQL and Aptitude Workshop (June 10-20, 2025), structured aptitude sessions were conducted daily. The sessions covered core placement topics like Number Systems, Profit & Loss, Ratios & Proportions, and more. Logical reasoning areas such as Direction Sense, Coding-Decoding, Blood Relations, and Cause-Effect were emphasized. Daily exercises were shared via Google Forms at 4 PM, promoting continuous practice and self-assessment. Students developed confidence in problem-solving and time management techniques. The training was designed to simulate real-time aptitude tests used in corporate hiring processes.

#### TMF-VISIT BY MR. ARUL, ASSOCIATE MANAGER




#### TMF - Internal Auditing Inspection Zoom meeting

On June 24, 2025 An internal auditing Zoom meeting was organized by Tech Mahindra Foundation for partner teams from South and East regions. The session was attended by Ms. Sindhu and Mr. Kevin (Accountant) from DBV SMART Perambur. The focus of the meeting was on refresher training related to operational protocols and compliance. Key discussions included Annexure formats, Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), and audit readiness. The objective was to ensure consistent SOP adherence and accurate documentation practices across centres. Participants gained clarity on reporting standards and improved their understanding of audit expectations.

#### Mock Interview By Ms. Arularasi, JPN

On June 25, 2025 a Mock Interview session was conducted by Ms. Arularasi for Batch 10034 at DBV SMART Perambur. A total of 17 students took part in this pre-demo activity to simulate real-time interview settings. The session aimed to enhance student confidence and improve placement readiness. Participants were evaluated on self-introduction, communication, subject knowledge, and presentation skills. Constructive feedback was shared to help students refine their responses and professional demeanor. The experience enabled students to identify areas of improvement and prepare effectively. This session was a key initiative in strengthening their interview skills and job market adaptability.



#### **NSDC-Inspection**

On June 25, 2025 an official NSDC Inspection was carried out at DBV SMART Perambur by Mr. Rufus from NSDC. The inspection focused on conducting due diligence of the centre's infrastructure, processes, and documentation. Various aspects such as training delivery, student engagement, and compliance standards were reviewed. Mr. Arulraj, Associate from Tech Mahindra Foundation, was also present during the inspection. The visit aimed to ensure the centre meets NSDC's quality benchmarks and operational protocols. Inspectors interacted with staff and reviewed key records related to training, attendance, and assessments. The session reinforced the importance of transparency, readiness, and SOP adherence.

#### Yuva & Basic It Exam - MIS Batch-2

On June 25, 2025 YUVA English and Basic IT assessments were conducted for Batch-II at DBV SMART Perambur. These exams were designed to evaluate students' language proficiency and digital literacy. A total of 25 out of 30 students successfully completed the assessments. The Basic IT exam focused on foundational computer skills essential for workplace readiness. The YUVA English assessment tested grammar, vocabulary, and communication abilities. The results will help trainers customize learning plans based on individual performance levels. This evaluation is a key step in tracking progress and preparing students for future placements.







#### PLACEMENT ASPIRATION FOR THE CURRENT BATCH - 01 25-26

As of June 27, 2025 the Placement Orientation for the current batches has been successfully completed. Students received guidance on job portals, resume building, and strategic application methods. The placement documentation process is currently underway and being compiled via Google Drive. Simultaneously, students are filling out the Placement Aspiration Google Form to capture their career interests. These steps are essential to align student profiles with relevant job opportunities. The data collected will support the creation of personalized placement plans and follow-ups. The process ensures structured and goal-oriented placement readiness for all students.




#### HTML, JAVA SCRIPT, CSS, MY SQL Worship by Mr. Suriya

#### Youth for a Cleaner Tomorrow: World Ocean Day Lake Cleanup at Korattur






