Dept. of Career Guidance

Career Guidance Program Don Bosco Hr. Sec. School, Vyasarpadi

On 4th July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti conducted a comprehensive Career Guidance Program for Class 10 & 12 students. 349 students actively participated in the session. The session covered various career paths after 12th, key entrance exams (NEET, JEE, CUET, etc.), and how to choose appropriate groups in class 11. Live examples, videos, and real-time questions helped students visualize their career journey. Students also received handouts detailing popular career streams and colleges. Teachers appreciated the clarity it brought to students' academic planning.



Career Guidance Program, Don Bosco Matric. Hr. Sec. School, TPT



On 8th July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti organized a Career Guidance Program focusing on Classes 10 & 12. 179 students engaged in a lively and thought-provoking session. Key highlights included the RIASEC Career Interest Test, an overview of competitive exams, and guidance on group selection. Students took part in an interactive career-mapping activity. They were also introduced to career opportunities in humanities and vocational training. Teachers remarked that it helped reduce confusion among students regarding career decisions.

Career Guidance Program St. Joseph's Al Hr. Sec. School, Perambur

On 12th July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti delivered a targeted career session for Class 12 students from Science and Commerce streams. 110 students attended with great interest. The program highlighted career paths like engineering-JEE, medicine-NEET, CA, CS, law CLAT and management. It included a segment on scholarships and application timelines for top institutions in India. Students were guided on how to research career fields using reliable online platforms. Many students later met the speakers personally for one-on-one clarification.



Workshop @ TMF Centre, Broadway



On 16th July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti facilitated a session for graduates on career planning and post-college opportunities. 43 short term course students participated in this motivational workshop. Topics included government exam preparation, private sector job skills, and internship portals. Special focus was given to personal branding on platforms like LinkedIn. The session ended with a Q&A where students shared their personal struggles and aspirations. Participants appreciated the real-world advice and practical tools provided.

Career Guidance Program Don Bosco Hr. Sec. School, Katpadi

On 21st July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti conducted an in-depth Career Guidance Program for 335 students of Classes 10 and 12. Topics included emerging careers in technology, finance, healthcare, and humanities. An “Interest Inventory” activity helped students match their strengths with potential careers.

A comparison of various streams, groups and their impact on college admissions was discussed. Students were shown success stories from the region to inspire them.

On 21st July 2025, Career Guidance Program was held at the Katpadi - DB Matric School by Don Bosco Vazhikaatti. 342 students from Classes 10, 11, and 12 participated with enthusiasm. This session included detailed walkthroughs of career paths in defense, design, sports, and media. Class 11 students explored how early preparation affects career options post-12th. Students appreciated the simple explanations of complicated entrance exam procedures. The session concluded with a motivational talk and a pledge to work towards their goals.

Lay Dimension Coordinators Formation Meet

On 24th July 2025, LDC Meet @ The Citadel, Kilpauk Don Bosco Vazhikaatti led the INM-Vocational Guidance segment at this coordinator meet. 27 representatives from Don Bosco schools, colleges, and technical institutes attended. The session focused on integrating career counseling within the academic curriculum. Participants shared the best practices from their institutions. The gathering helped create a roadmap for structured vocational guidance across Don Bosco institutions.



BEST program at Idhaya College

On 28th July 2025 to 1st July 2025, Don Bosco Vazhikaatti hosted a week-long “Building Futures” BEST program at Idhaya College for 320 final-year students. Each day focused on a different theme: communication, goal setting, personality traits, interview skills, and competitive exams. Mock interviews, aptitude tests, and group discussions were part of the learning experience. Special sessions on government jobs, digital careers, and entrepreneurship were conducted. Students were provided with a career planning workbook to map their future. College authorities commended the depth and structure of the training.

Job Fair

A job fair was successfully organized on 19th July 2025 at Sacred Heart Church, Polur, in collaboration with Don Bosco Vazhikaatti and Equitas Trust, under the banner of the Don Bosco Job Placement Network. The event witnessed the participation of 115 manually registered candidates, and 23 reputed companies offered over 210 job opportunities across various sectors. Job Drive

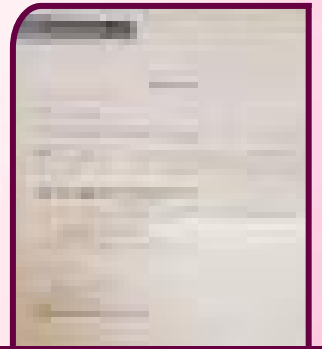

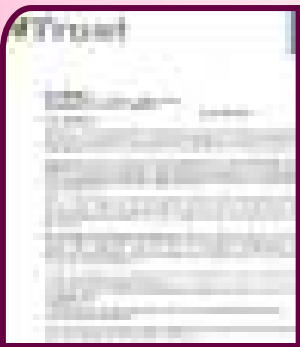
